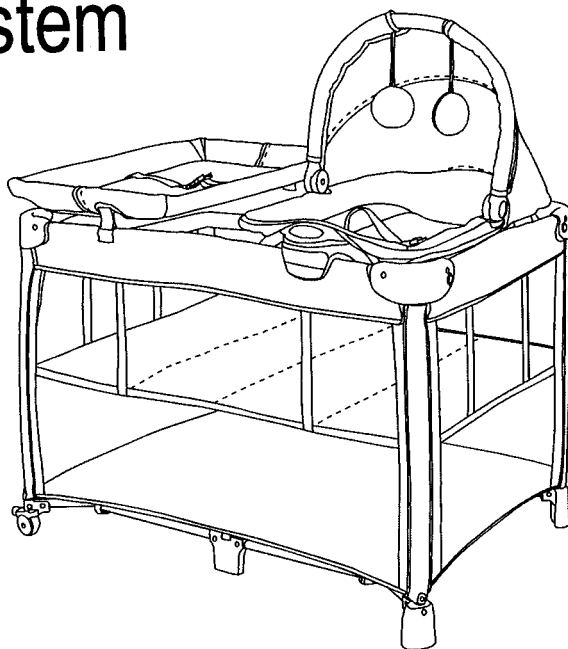

Do not use mattress other than the one supplied by the manufacturer.

Incorrect mattress can cause death.

Use only accessories as recommended by the manufacturer.

Ensure the top rails and base are fully locked.

Stop using this cot if any part of the cot is broken, torn or missing.

KEEP THESE INSTRUCTIONS IN A SAFE PLACE FOR FUTURE REFERENCE.

Introduction:

Congratulations on purchasing your Nested Completo Sleep System.

This product has been designed and developed with safety, comfort and functionality in mind. Please take the time to read this manual carefully before using this product and keep it in a safe place for future reference.

From nap time to play time to diaper time, the Nested Completo Sleep System has you covered on the go. This travel cot comes with a wipe-clean changing unit and a cosy rocking infant seat. The easy attachment system allows the changing unit and rocker to pop on or off with a click.

The removable bassinet makes the Nested Completo Sleep System just right for younger babies, giving you easy and comfortable access to your little one. This cot also includes all around mesh for ventilation. The travel cot folds at the push of a button, fitting neatly into the on the go carry bag.

Once baby can sit up unaided, you can move on from the bassinet and use the full depth of the cot. Just remove the bassinet and lower the padded mattress to the bottom of the travel cot for nap time up to 15kg.

When set on the floor, the portable seat can be gently rocked to soothe baby. The cocoon-shaped rocker has a canopy with 2 detachable plush toys.

THE CORRECT USE AND MAINTENANCE OF THIS PRODUCT IS ESSENTIAL.

WARNINGS:

- USE ONLY THE MATTRESS SUPPLIED BY THE MANUFACTURER, INCORRECT MATTRESSES CAN CAUSE DEATH.
- USE ONLY ACCESSORIES AS RECOMMENDED BY THE SUPPLIER.
- ENSURE THE TOP RAILS AND BASE ARE FULLY LOCKED.
- DO NOT USE THIS COT IF ANY PART OF THE COT IS BROKEN, TORN OR MISSING.
- THIS BASSINET SHOULD BE REMOVED BEFORE THE CHILD CAN SIT UP.
- TO PREVENT FALLS, THE BASSINET MUST NOT BE USED ONCE A CHILD CAN SIT UP.
- NEVER PLACE A CHILD IN THE COT WHEN THIS BASSINET IS IN PLACE.
- THIS BASSINET IS INTENDED FOR ONE CHILD UP TO 6 MONTHS OR WEIGHING UP TO A MAXIMUM OF 9KG.
- FALL HAZARD – To help prevent falls, do not use the bassinet when the infant begins to push up on hands and knees or has reached 9kg (20lbs), whichever comes first. Do not use when the child can sit or kneel or pull itself up.
- NEVER LEAVE CHILD UNATTENDED.
- Discontinue using changer when child reaches 11kg (approximately 0-12 months) or is able to climb out or can sit unaided.
- Always read and follow assembly instructions for each product use mode (bassinet, cot and rocker).
- Keep instructions for future use.
- Keep children away while assembling/disassembling the cot.
- Do not leave anything on the folding cot (such as toys) that provide a foothold.
- Do not use the folding cot near naked heat sources, bar heaters, open fires or exposed flames.

Safety Precautions:

- Do not place more than one child in the cot at the same time.
- Do not add an extra mattress as this may cause suffocation.
- Do not use this cot with a child who can climb out, weighs more than 15kg, or is taller than 890mm.
- The cot must be placed on a horizontal floor. Young children must not be allowed to play unsupervised in the vicinity of this product.
- It is dangerous to place the product on a raised surface such as a table. Only an adult should assemble, fold and unfold this product. Ensure users of this product are knowledgeable on its correct operation.
- DO NOT position the cot near walls and obstacles to prevent entrapment.
- DO NOT adjust the product with the child inside.
- DO NOT move the product with the child inside.
- DO NOT use the product with more than one child at a time.
- DO NOT use this product if any parts are missing, damaged or broken.
- Keep the folding cot clear of trailing cables and hanging cords.
- Keep medication and small items that a child could choke on, away from the cot.
- Check that the assembly of the cot is correct and safe.
- Check that all locking devices are fully engaged.
- Folding cots with padded rims should not be used if the covering material has been bitten through.
- There is potential for fingers or parts of the body to be injured when the product is being folded or unfolded, and that due care should be exercised.
- Take care when unpacking and during assembly.
- Dispose of all packing materials carefully after assembly.
- Regularly check that all fittings remain tight. Tighten if required.
- Inspect the product before assembly and periodically during use. Never use this product if there are any loose or missing fasteners, joints or broken parts.
- To reduce the risk of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS), paediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless advised by your physician.
- Be aware of the risk of open fires and other sources of strong heat, such as electric bar fires, gas fires, etc. in the near vicinity of the product.
- Always use ALL required parts for each use mode. Check instruction manual for a list of required parts. Periodically check product for loose, damaged or missing parts.

Safety Precautions:

- DO NOT use cot if any parts are missing, damaged or broken. Contact the manufacturer for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed.
- DO NOT substitute parts.



WARNINGS:

SUFFOCATION HAZARD

INFANTS HAVE SUFFOCATED:

- IN GAPS BETWEEN AN EXTRA PADDING AND SIDE OF THE BASSINET.
 - ON SOFT BEDDING.
 - USE ONLY THE PAD PROVIDED BY THE MANUFACTURER. NEVER ADD A PILLOW, COMFORTER OR ANOTHER MATTRESS FOR PADDING.
- The bassinet is designed to provide a sleeping area for an infant until he or she begins to push up on hands and knees or approximately 6 months of age, weighing up to a maximum 9kg.
 - When a child is able to sit, kneel or to pull itself up, the bassinet shall not to be used anymore for this child.
 - To reduce the risk of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS), pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician. To avoid death from the infant's neck being caught on the top rail on the side that is next to the adult bed, the top rail must be no higher than the adult bed mattress.
 - Strings can cause strangulation! DO NOT place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. DO NOT suspend strings over a bassinet or cradle or attach strings to toys.
 - DO NOT place a product near a window where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.
 - The thickness of the mattress must be such that vertical height (upper surface on the mattress until the upper edge of the product's sides) is at least 200mm.
 - DO NOT use more than one mattress in the cot.
 - DO NOT leave any item in the product that could reduce its depth.
 - The product is ready for use only when all locking mechanisms are engaged. Check carefully that these are engaged before use.

Safety Precautions:

- **SUFFOCATION HAZARD:** Discard all packing materials immediately after opening.
- Plastic bags and ties may cause suffocation or choking.
- **NEVER** use plastic shopping bags or other plastic film as mattress covers not sold and intended for that purpose. They can cause suffocation.
- Be aware of the risk of open fires and other sources of strong heat, such as electric bar fires, etc. in the near vicinity of the cot.
- If a sheet is used with the mattress, use only the one provided by the manufacturer or one specifically designed to fit the dimension of the mattress.
- This product conforms to AS/NZS 2195:2010 + A1:2013 + A2:2015

The rocking seat is suitable for one child from birth (max. weight 9kg).

WARNING! Follow the manufacturer's instructions.

WARNING! Prevent serious injury or death.

WARNING! NEVER leave the child unattended.

WARNING! ALWAYS use the restraint system.

WARNING! DO NOT use the reclined cradle once your child can sit unaided.

WARNING! Do not attempt to move or lift the product when a child is in it.

WARNING! Never use the reclined cradle on an elevated surface e.g. a table.

WARNING! **SUFFOCATION HAZARD:** Never use on a soft surface (bed, sofa, cushion), as seat may tip over and cause suffocation.

WARNING! This reclined cradle is not intended for prolonged periods of sleeping.

- Never leave baby in the rocking seat without supervision.
- Do not use the rocking seat once the child can sit up unaided.
- Baby's movements could make the rocking seat tip over.
- Always use the restraint system, ensuring it is correctly adjusted at all times.
- Before using, check that all parts are properly locked into position and adjusted correctly.
- Do not use this product on an elevated surface i.e. a table. Place on stable, dry, level floor only.
- Never place the rocking seat on a soft surface (bed, sofa, cushion), as seat may tip over and be dangerous for baby.
- This product does not replace a cot or cot bed. Should your child need to sleep, then it should be placed in a suitable cot or cot bed.
- The rocking seat is not a carrycot, nor a car seat.

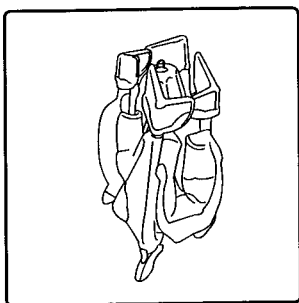
Safety Precautions:

- Always use the straps and adjust them properly, even if baby will only be in the rocking seat for a short time.
- Do not use near an open fire or any other kind of heater.
- Keep the plastic bags of the packaging out of reach of babies and young children to avoid any risk of suffocation.
- Never add any pillow, blanket or padding to the rocking seat.
- Do not put objects with strings around the neck of your baby, do not hang strings from the rocking seat and do not attach strings to toys. This could lead to strangling.
- Do not put the rocking seat close to a window where the strings of a blind or curtains could lead to strangling.
- Do not attach other toys than those supplied.
- **NEVER** place a child under 2.26 kg (5 lbs) or over 9 kg (20 lbs) in the product.
- Discontinue use of product should it malfunction or become damaged.
- Do not use this product if any components are broken or missing.
- Only use authorised additional replacement parts. Do not use accessories or replacement parts other than those approved by the manufacturer.
- Keep children away from the product during assembly and when not in use.
- Do not let other children play unattended near the product. Adult assembly required.

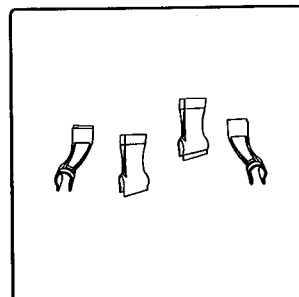
(D) bassinet compression tubes

To Unfold the Travel Cot:

Step 1. Unpack all contents and check that all parts are present before starting assembly. Please refer to parts list.
Unzip the storage/ travel bag (H) and remove the travel cot (A) and mattress (B).

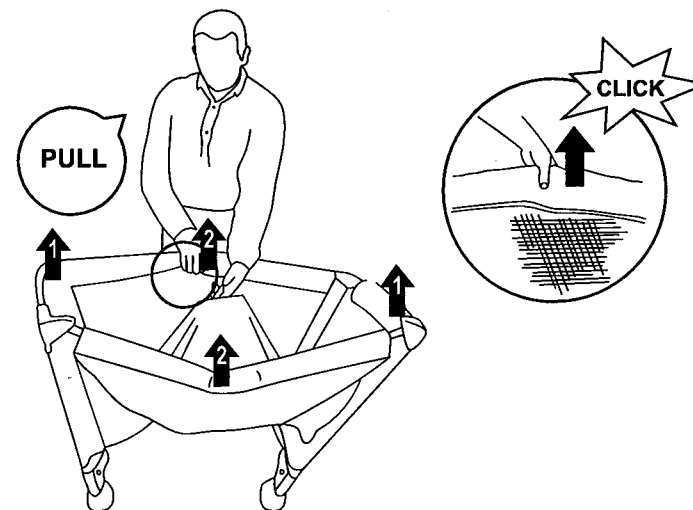


Step 2. Place the travel cot in a vertical position. Open the velcro webbing fasteners to remove the mattress.

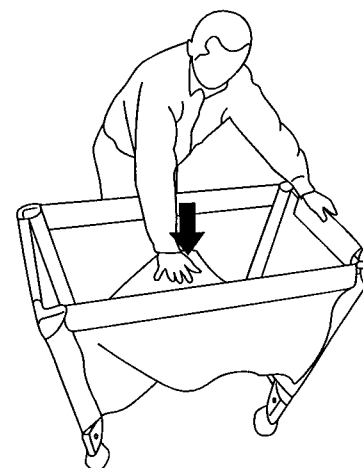


To Unfold the Travel Cot:

Step 3. With the travel cot feet on the floor pull them apart so that they are approximately 60cm/ 24" apart. Lift the smaller sides upwards until they lock into position. Repeat for the longer side rails.

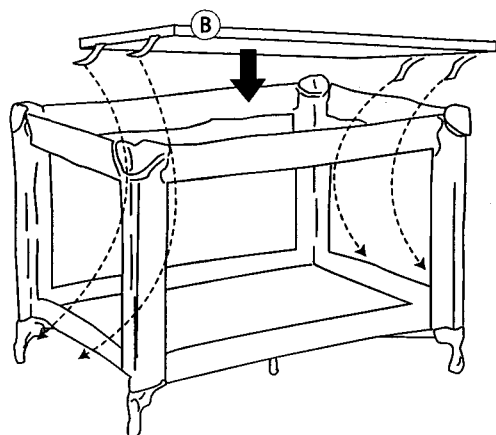


Step 4. Push the bottom center until it is completely flat and stable.



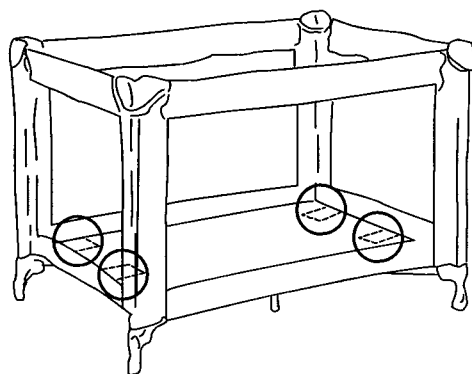
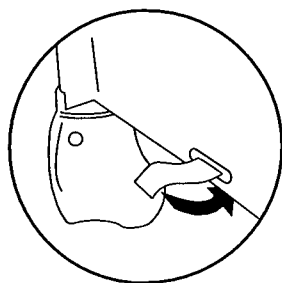
To Unfold the Travel Cot:

Step 5. Place the mattress (B) in the travel cot with the padded side up. Insert the four velcro tabs through the slots in the bottom of the travel cot.



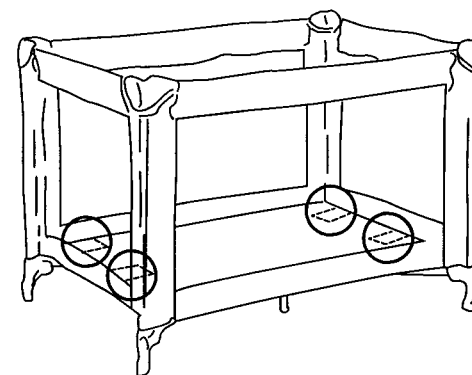
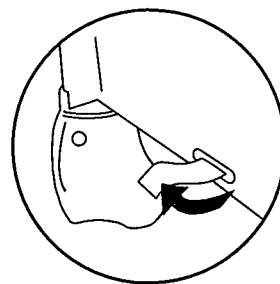
Step 6. Fold back the tabs and secure underneath the travel cot to secure the padded base into position.

WARNING! Ensure all locking mechanisms are engaged before use.

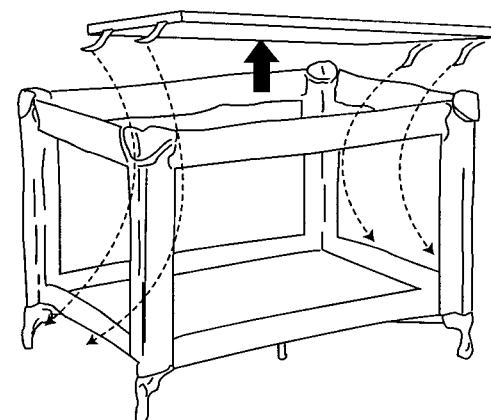


To Fold the Travel Cot:

Step 1. Undo the four velcro tabs from underneath the travel cot.

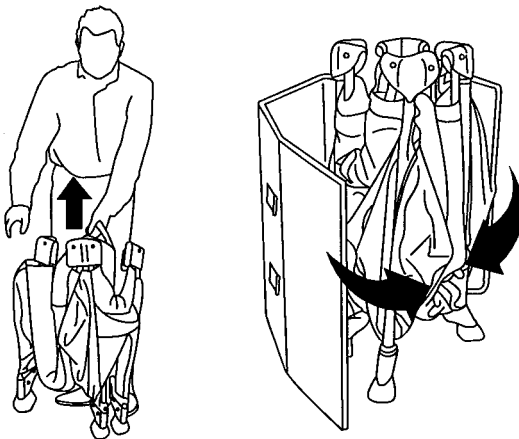


Step 2. Remove the velcro tabs from the base of the travel cot and remove the padded base.

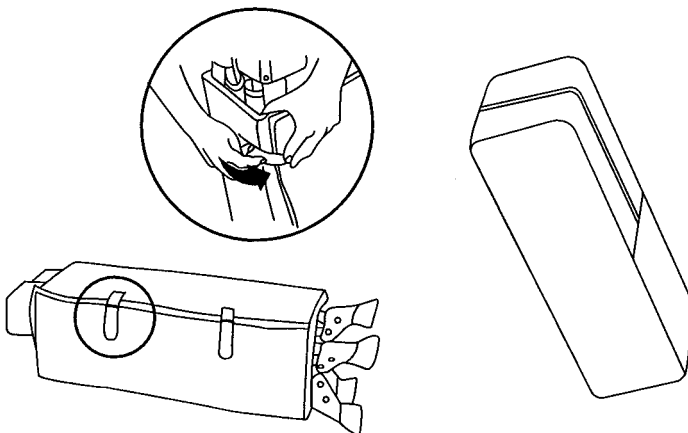


To Fold the Travel Cot:

Step 5. Push all the feet together so that the upper part of the travel cot is in the closed position. Wrap the padded base around the travel cot with the padded section facing inside.

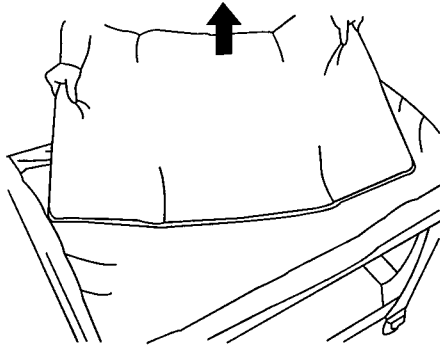


Step 6. Fasten the velcro webbing fasteners and secure. Place travel cot back into the bag for storage or transportation.

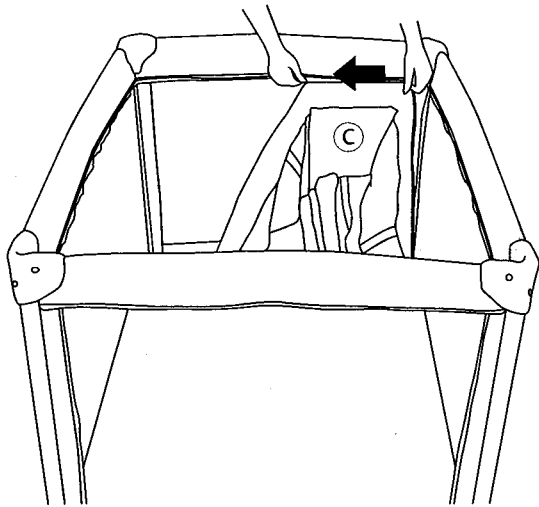


Bassinet:

Step 1. Remove the mattress from the bottom of the travel cot to use with the bassinet.

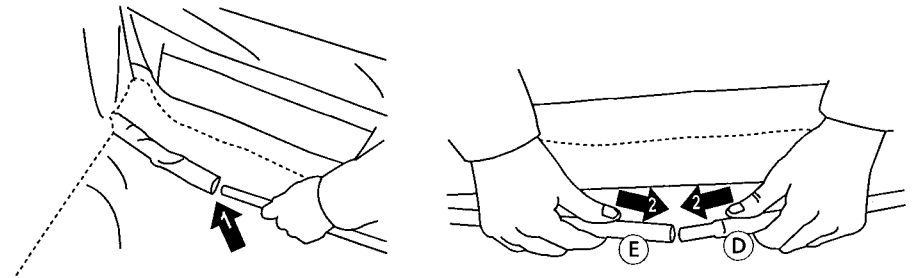


Step 2. Zip the bassinet (C) onto the travel cot with the tube sleeves facing up.



Bassinet:

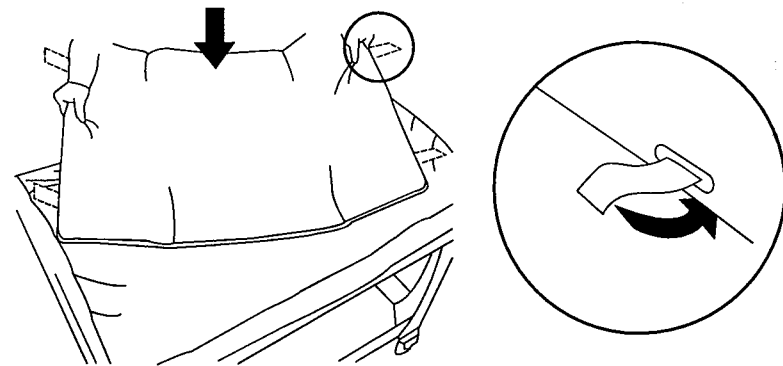
Step 3. Insert the compression (D) and support (E) tubes into the sleeves until they are locked into place.
Repeat step for the rest of the metal tubes.



Step 4. Place the padded base into bassinet.

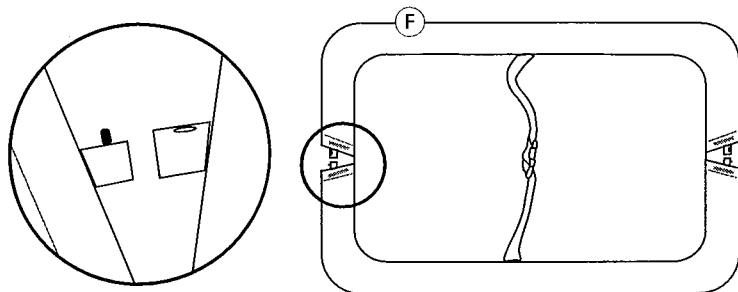
Step 5. Insert the velcro tabs into the slots each corner of the bassinet, fold back the tabs and fix underneath to secure the padded base into position.

WARNING! Ensure all locking mechanisms are engaged before use.

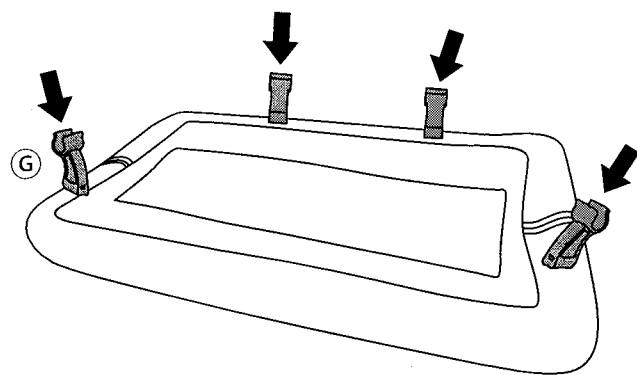


Change Table:

Step 1. Unfold the change table (F) and tidy the surface. Open the velcro at both ends and press the spring pin to join the steel tubes. A "click" will signal it is secure. Fasten the velcro.



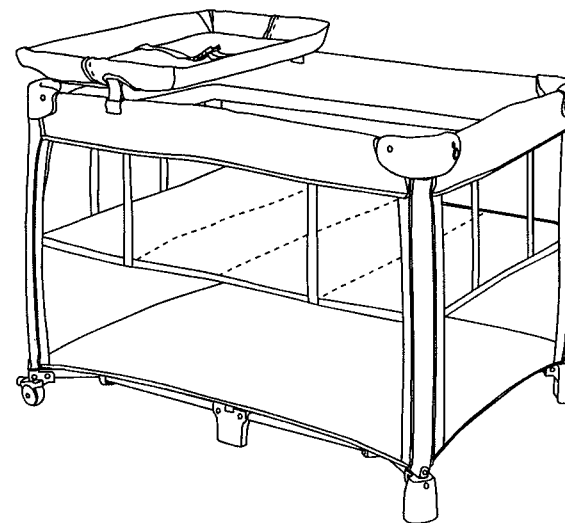
Step 2. Attach the 4 plastic clips (G) to the underside of the change table. Push in firmly.



Change Table:

Step 3. Attach the change table to the travel cot.

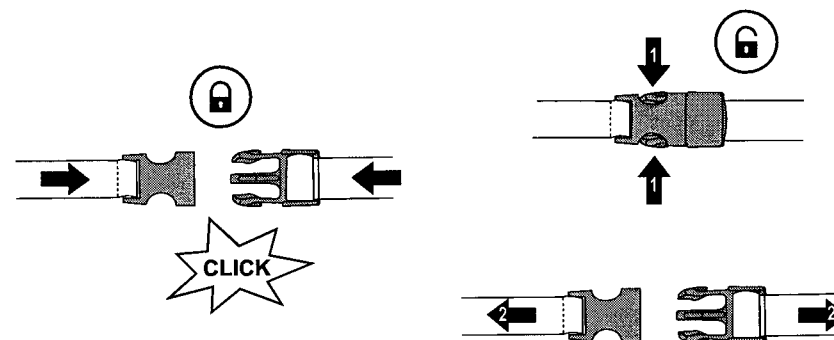
NOTE. Always make sure the plastic clips are securely fastened to the change table and the travel cot when installed.



Step 4. Always use the harness when the change table is in use.

WARNING! Never place a child in the cot when this change table is in place.

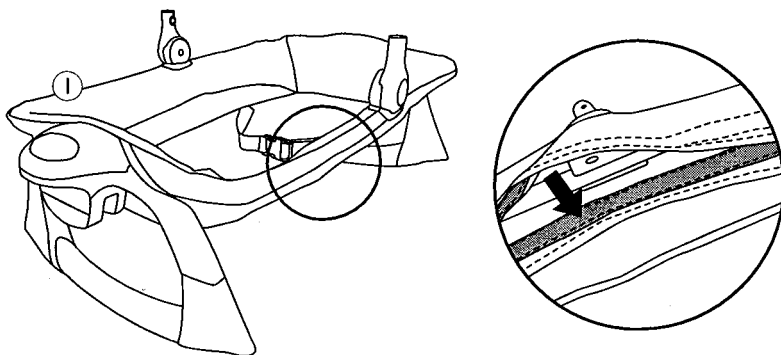
WARNING! Always put the change table away when not in use.



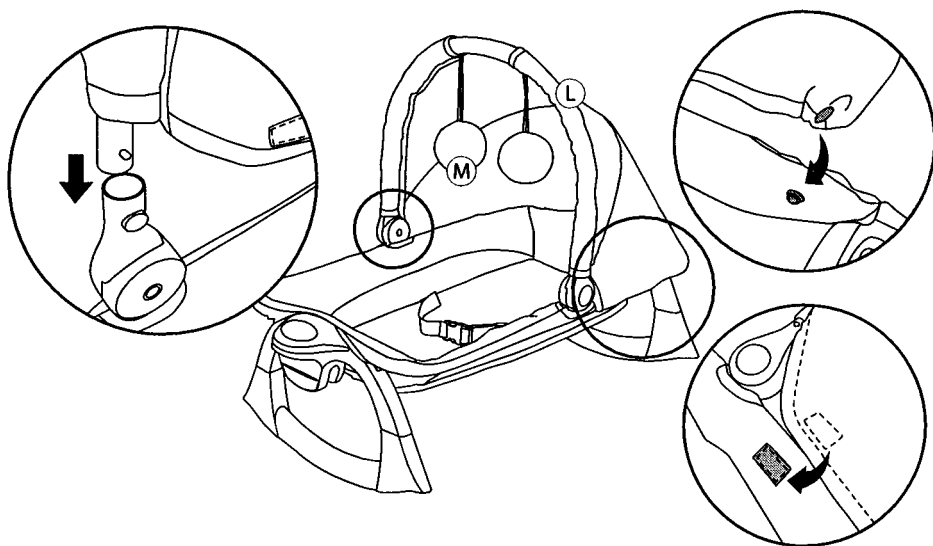
Rocker Assembly:

Step 3. Attach the rocker body (I) to the assembled frame. Insert the connectors all the way through the holes in the rocker body. Pull the rocker body fabric down over the support tubes and fasten the velcro panels.

NOTE. Ensure the folded connectors are facing towards the press studs on the rocker body. These press studs are for the canopy.



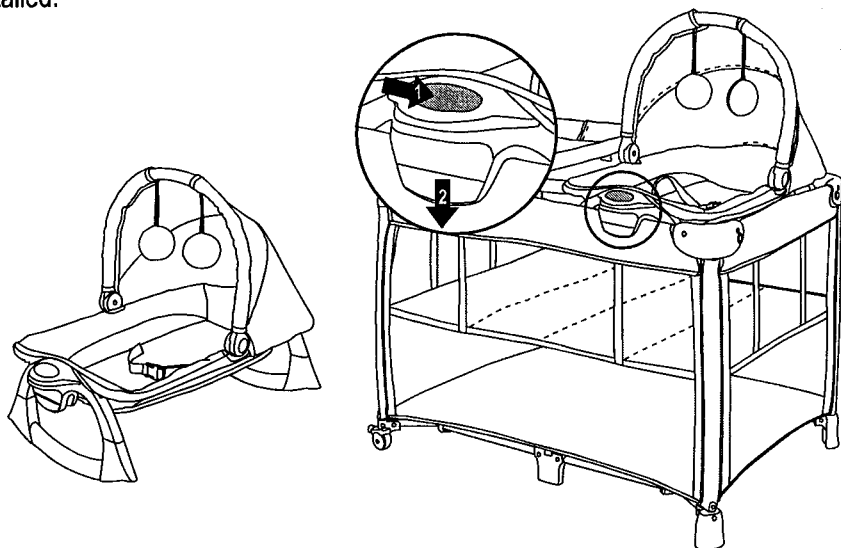
Step 4. Push in the spring pins and insert the end of the canopy (L) tube into the seat body connectors. A “click” will signal it is secure. Fasten the press studs and the velcro. Attach the toys (M) to the canopy.



Rocker Assembly:

Step 5. The rocker seat can be used on both the floor or you can attach it to the travel cot. Push in the buttons on the top of the legs and attach the legs to the travel cot side rails.

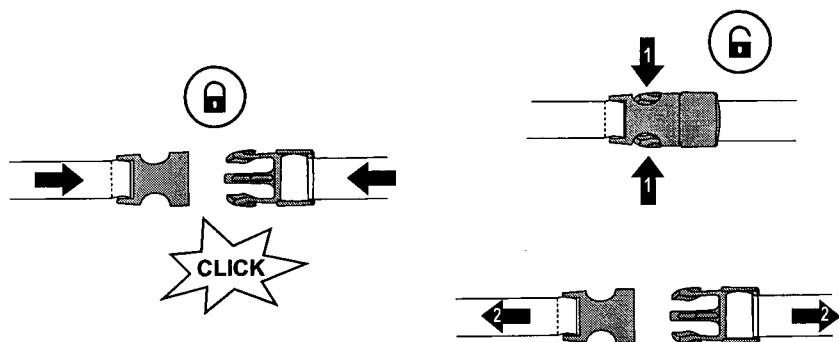
NOTE. Always make sure the legs are securely fastened to the travel cot when installed.



Step 6. Always use the harness when the rocker is in use.

WARNING! Never place a child in the cot when this rocker is in place.

WARNING! Always put the rocker away when not in use.



Maintenance:

Always check parts regularly for tightness of bolts, nuts and other fasteners - tighten or replace if required.

Check the strength of the fabric covers from time to time. Defective or worn parts must be replaced; as should components which are broken, torn, defective or worn out.

Use only parts and accessories approved by the manufacturer.

Cleaning:

Spot clean the mattress, bassinet and cot fabrics using mild soap or upholstery shampoo. NEVER use bleach. Air dry in shade thoroughly before reuse and avoid direct heat and sunlight. DO NOT iron. DO NOT dry clean.

Check the resistance of the fabric and the stitching after cleaning.

Wipe the frame using warm water and a mild detergent. NEVER use bleach. Never clean any part of the cot with abrasive, ammonia based, bleach based or spirit type cleaners.

Ensure the product is fully dry before use or storage.

Always ensure the cot is stored in a dry place to prevent mold or mildew developing. Store away from any heat sources and not in the sun.
