Notice regarding i-Size category Enhanced Child Restraint Systems (40-105cm)

This is an i-Size Enhanced Child Restraint System. It is approved according to UN Regulation No. 129, for use in, i-Size compatible vehicle seating positions as indicated by vehicle manufacturers in the vehicle users' manual. If in doubt, consult either the Enhanced Child Restraint System manufacturer or the retailer.

Notice regarding i-Size booster seat category Enhanced Child Restraint Systems(100-150cm)

This is an i-Size booster seat Enhanced Child Restraint System.It is approved according to UN Regulation No. 129, for use primarily in "i-Size seating positions" as indicated by vehicle manufacturers in the vehicle user's manual.If in doubt, consult either the Enhanced Child Restraint System manufacturer or the retailer

"IMPORTANT – DO NOT USE FORWARD FACING BEFORE THE CHILD'S AGE EXCEEDS 15 MONTHS (Refer to instructions)".

NOT TO USE REARWARD FACING ECRS IN SEATING POSITIONS WHERE THERE IS AN ACTIVE FRONTAL AIRBAG INSTALLED.


2. Warnings

For your child's safety, please read these instructions carefully before use and keep them for future reference. Failure to follow the instructions contained in this manual could result in serious injury to your child.

- 1. This child safety seat can only be used with the harness for children 40-105cm height.
- 2. This instruction manual can be retained in the special space of the child seat for its life period.
- 3. Do not use this child car seat at home. It has not been designed for home use and should only be used in your car.
- 4. Never leave your child unattended in the child restraint system even for a short time.
- The child safety seat should be changed when it has been subject to violent stresses in an accident.
- 6. This child restraint should be securely belted in the vehicle even when not in use. In a crash or sudden stop, an unsecured child safety seat may injure other occupants.
- 7. Always make sure that any straps holding the seat restraint to the vehicle shall be tight, any straps restraining the child should be adjusted to the child's body, and check that the straps shall not be twisted.
- 8. IMPORTANT! Ensuring that any lap straps is worn low down, so that the pelvis is firmly engaged.

- 9. Do not use any load bearing contact points other than those described in the instructions and marked in the child restraint ,when in doubt ,please contact the child restraint manufacturer.
- 10. Any luggage or other objects liable to cause injuries in the event of a collision shall be properly secured.
- 11. The rigid items and plastic parts of a child restraint must be so located and installed that they are not liable, during everyday use of the vehicle to become trapped by a moveable seat or in a door of the vehicle.
- 12. To prevent from fall, your child should always be fastened.
- 13. It is dangerous to make any alteration or additions to the device without the approval of the competent authority, and a danger of not following closely the installation instructions provided by the child restraint manufacturer.
- 14. This child safety seat is designed for children from 9 to 36 kg.Never overload the child safety seat more than one child or with other loads.
- 15. The child restraint must not be used without the cover.
- **16.** The seat cover should not be replaced with any other than the one recommended by the manufacturer, because the cover constitutes an integral part of the restraint performance.
- 17. Before you adjust any movable or adjustable parts of your child safety seat, you must remove your baby from the child safety seat.
- 18. The child safety seat should be kept away from sunlight if the seat is not provided with a textile, otherwise it may be too hot for the child's skin.
- 19. Never use a second-hand product, as you can never be certain what was happened to it.
- 20. Notice: Do not use in any configuration not shown in the instructions.
- 21. Importance! Before using ISOFIX child restraint system, please read carefully the manual of automobile manufacturer about the instruction of ISOFIX fix point.




5. Use in the vehicle



- A ISOFIX Attachments
- 3-point Safety Belt

When using as i-Size

This ECRS system is suitable for vehicles equipped with the R16 requirements. And only after installed ISOFIX, then can use on it

- (X) Unable to install the position
- (?) When front the of the seat with opened airbag,cannot install in this place.
- Only with ISOFIX attachments can intall in this place.

6.1 Height adjustment for head support and shoulder harnesses

Please adjust the head support and check if the shoulder harnesses are at the correct height for your child.

Notice: When used rear facing and forward facing, the shoulder harness height must be even with or just above the child's shoulders









Step 1: Press the adjuster button under the cover and at the same time pull both shoulder straps forward.





Note! The height for the harness is adjusted by lifting the headrest.


Step 2:Pull the height adjuster to adjust the height of the harness and the headrest according to the child's height.






Step 3:Pull the adjuster strap until the harness is fully tightened.

6.2 Using the buckle





Locking Method:

Align the left and right buckle tongues to one tongue and insert into the buckle until you hear a "Click" $\,$.

Unlocking Method:

You can press the red button of the buckle downwards, the two metal sections will be pop up.

6.3 Unlock ISOFIX









To remove from the vehicle press the ISOFIX adjuster button(fig.1)and pull the base back from the seat(fig.2)

Transit to prevent damage during.Press the ISOFIX adjuster button and fold the connector completely(fig.3)

In order to lock the isofix connector to the steel point successfully, it can use isofix guide.




Step 1:Find out ISOFIX connection in the car.



Step 2: Insert ISOFIX guides to assist with installation





 $\mbox{\bf Step 3:} \mbox{\bf Make sure that both ISOFIX connectors are securely attached to their ISOFIX anchor points.}$

Notice 1: Make sure that both ISOFIX connectors are securely attached to their ISOFIX anchor points. The colors of the indicators on the both ISOFIX connectors should be completely green

Notice 2: Check to make sure the base is securely installed by pulling on the both ISOFIX conectors.

6.4 Adjust the backrest angle



The forward and rearward installation of the safety seat has three adjustable angles. Please select the appropriate tilt angle according to the following different installation groups.


Rearward installation 40-105cm: 4th gear Forward installation 76-105: 1st-3rd gear

Forward installation 100-150: 1st gear

NOTICE:When the safety seat is installed in rearward direction, the tilt angle can be adjusted in three gears, but only the 4th gear can be used.

How to use: lift up the angle adjusting handle under the front of the seat, then pull it forward or push it backward. When the desired gear is reached, release the angle adjusting handle, and finally push the seat until the "click" sound is heard.

6.5 Instructions for seat rotation




Step 1: Move the rotation lock button to the unlock position.

Step 2: Use another hand to rotate the child car seat.

NOTICE: Please pull the rotation lock button into the lock position again so that the child car seat is secure.





Step 3: When the "CLICK" is heard the base is locked.

NOTICE: Please make sure the seat is locked and can not rotate before driving WARNING: Please take care when rotating the seat as your fingers could become trapped.




WARNING

- During driving, seat is not allowed to rotate to the side facing position. Side facing position will not protect the child in case a collision.
- Backrest can only be locked with base when turn to farward facing and rearward facing and it can not be locked when turn to the side.

7.1 Installation(40-105CM)


* Removing sleeping pad






NOTICE:When your child's height exceed 75cm, remove the sleeping pad.

Installed in Rearward facing position with ISOFIX and top tether(40-105cm)




Step 1: Press the ISOFIX adjuster button to extend the ISOFIX(B1)



Step 2:Find out ISOFIX connection in the car(B2).



Step 3: Push child seat follow the direction ,until isofix connectors are completely locked with the connection device of car (B3).




NOTICE:Make sure that both ISOFIX connectors are securely attached to their ISOFIX anchor points.The colors of the indicators on the both ISOFIX connectors should be completely green




Step 4: child safety seat must be against the car seat firmly(B4) .

Notice:The child safety seat not be against the car seat, It is very dangerous.







Step 5: Press the adjusting button and adjust the belt of top tether to the longest(B5).




Step 6: Connect top tether with the fixing point on the car(B6)







Notice 1: Check that the harness does not twisted.
Notice 2: During driving, seat is not allowed to rotate to the side facing position. Side facing position will not protect the child in case a collision.





A NOTICE:

- backrest can only be locked with base when turn to farward facing and rearward facing and it can not be locked when turn to the side.
- 2. Pease pull the swivel button again ,when the seat can not be swivedled into place .
- 3. Please make sure the seat is locked and can not rotate before driving
- 4. When rotating the seat, please take care of the child's feet.




NOTICE: When the safety seat is installed in rearward direction, the tilt angle can be adjusted in three gears, but only the 4th gear can be used.


Important -Do not using forward-facing before the child's weight exceeds 9 kg.

7.2 Installation(76-105CM)

Installed in forward facing position with ISOFIX and top tether(76-105cm)
IMPORTANT:Do not use forward facing before the child's age exceeds 15 months




Step 1: Press the ISOFIX adjuster button to extend the ISOFIX(Fig.C1)



Step 2:Find out ISOFIX connection in the car(C2).



Step 3: Push child seat follow the direction ,until ISOFIX connectors are completely locked with the connection device of car.




NOTICE: Make sure that both ISOFIX connectors are securely attached to their ISOFIX anchor points. The colors of the indicators on the both ISOFIX connectors should be completely green




Step 4: child safety seat must be against the car seat firmly(C4).

Notice:The child safety seat not be against the car seat. It is very dangerous






Step 5: Press the adjusting button and adjust the belt of top tether to the longest(C5).





Step 6: Connect top tether with the fixing point on the car




Step 7: String the belt of top tether until the adjuster shows green(C7).

⚠ Roll up the extra ribbons and put them away to prevent baby from playing, It is very dangerous .





Step 8: Press the webbing adjustment button, while pulling out the shoulder harnesses to the proper length(C8)



Step 9:Unlock the buckle of the harnesses by pressing the red button(C9)



Step 10:Put the child into the seat and fasten the harness ,then pull the adjuster strap until the harness is fully tightened(C10).

Notice: Check that the harness does not twisted.


7.3 Installation(100-150CM)

The baby car seat installation can choose to use ISOFIX or not.



1.Using ISOFIX:


Connect ISOFIX with anchorage point on the car seat(D1)






2.Not using ISOFIX:

Hide ISOFIX in the booster. Put the seat against the car seat(D2)







Step 2:Release the buckle(D4)




Step 3: Pass the seat belt in the direction of the arrow and remove the shoulder guards on both sides(D5).



Step 4:keep the removed cushion and accessories well(D6).



Step 5:Hide the strap of both sides behind the backrest cover.(D7).



Step 6:Place the buckle in the booster(under the cover)(D8).



16.2 Securing the child

Step 1: Put the seat against the car seat(D9)
Notice: The child safety seat not be against the car seat. It is very dangerous
Notice: Adjust the seat angle to first gear.






Step 2: Put the child in the seat (D11) and follow D12,D13 routine 1 2 3 to securing the child.







Step3:Use the height adjuster to adjust the height of the headrest according to the child's height. The gap between head belt guide and baby is 2 finger width. The harness straps should be level with or just above the child's shoulders (D14,D15).






Step 4: Fasten vehicle belt and make sure, it is tight enough. (D16)

Important:Ensuring that any lap straps is worn low down,so that the pelvis is firmly engaged,shall be stressed.

8. Remove the fabric cover





Step 3:pull all directions to take out the cover(E2).

Repeat the process in reverse to replace the cover.

9. Maintenance and cleaning

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Periodically inspect your child seat for worn or damaged parts. If damaged parts are found, replace the child seat Keep the child seat clean.Do no lubricate any parts of the child seat. To prolong the life of your nursery product, keep it clean and do not leave it in direct sunlight for extended periods of time. Removable fabric covers and trims may be cleaned using warm water with a household soap or a mild detergent. Allow it to dry fully, preferably away from direct sunlight.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Food, drink, or other debris may collect inside the harness buckle which can affect proper functioning Wash in warm water until clean.Be sure you can hear an audible click to make sure the buckle is working properly.

CLEANING THE HARNESS AND SHELL

Sponge clean using warm water and mild soap; do not use any other cleaning agents.

STORAGE

Store in a safe, dry place and away from heat and direct sunlight. Avoid placing heavy objects on top of the seat.

10.Warranty
